Our Project Manager, Des Baker, and Lead TSM, Ian Knight, is currently working with our pharmaceutical client to deliver a replacement of MRI unit into their Bio-Imaging department facility. Highline was appointed to take the project from client concept through to D&B scheme, which involved a services upgrade and architectural layout and finishes. This project will involve the re-purposing of four separate areas to establish a new prep area and MRI tech area, as well as the necessary temporary works for the removal of the Faraday Cage to enable the MRI replacement.
